The SMRID awards up to fifteen annual scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 each to students who either:

- have irrigation acres
- whose parents have irrigation acres
- students with parents employed by ratepaying irrigators; or
- students of SMRID Staff.

The student must be entering 2nd, 3rd, 4th, or 5th year of full-time study at a recognized university, college or technical institute. Preferential consideration will be given to students enrolled in an agriculturally related program of study. This application, along with a copy of the student's official transcript showing the courses taken and grades received during their post-secondary education, must be received at the SMRID office by **AUGUST 31st**. Funds will be disbursed to successful applicants in two equal installments upon receipt of proof of registration from the university, college or technical institute.

- students who are ratepaying irrigators within the District
 - students whose parents are ratepaying irrigators within the District
 - students whose parents are employed by ratepaying irrigators within the District
 - students of District staff

- **entering 2nd, 3rd, 4th, or 5th year of a recognized university, college, or technical institute**
- AMOUNTS:**
- 10 @ \$2,000 each
- CRITERIA:**
- full-time student
 - preferential consideration will be given to students enrolled in an agriculturally related program of study
 - post-secondary accumulated GPA (scholastic ability not financial need)
 - whether or not a previous recipient (everything else being equal, a new applicant would have priority over a previous recipient)
 - education and career goals
- OBLIGATION:**
- provide marks from all previous year's post-secondary education
 - provide outline of education and career objectives
 - provide official confirmation of full-time registration in first semester
 - after completion of first semester, provide proof of successful completion and official confirmation of full-time registration in second semester (does not have to be consecutive semesters, but should lie within institute's calendar year - i.e.: Sept. 1 to Sept. 1)
 - an application may be reconsidered if a student changes his/her course of study after the initial award
 - provide proof of eligibility if requested from the District

- PAYMENT:**
- two equal installments upon receipt of above confirmations \$1,000 after confirmation of registration in first semester. \$1,000 after receipt of **successful** completion of first semester and registration in a second semester
