SMRID hereby grants consent to the Applicant to discharge water into open channels, pipe drain or reservoirs of the SMRID under the following conditions:

1. Application must be approved by SMRID before starting.
2. **Applicant must not have used manure on the land for six months prior to request for pumping.**
3. Applicant must provide E. Coli and Total Coliforms testing results on request.
4. Applicant must submit any third-party consents to the District’s office.
5. Applicant must receive verbal confirmation and have signed document of approval from one of the following:

 - Scott Marose – Operations Assistant Manager - West @ 403-332-2209
 - Richard Oliver – Operations Assistant Manager - Central @ 403-892-4925
 - Mike Zmurchyk – Operations Assistant Manager - East @ 403-581-6860
6. Applicant must notify the District (403-328-4401) when pumping is completed.
7. Applicant must cease pumping temporarily if requested to do so by SMRID staff.
8. When setting up, minimize ground disturbance. No “pushing “water to pump – relocate as required. Mitigation (e.g., silt fence, filter material) may be required.
9. Flow rate limited to 300USGM (~ 3” pump), unless otherwise stated below.
